Experience the Dundreggan estate and Rewilding Centre

Just eight miles from the shores of Loch Ness, the Dundreggan Rewilding Centre is a gateway to Trees for Life's 10,000-acre Dundreggan estate.

Rewilded by Trees for Life since 2008, Dundreggan is home to more than 4,000 kinds of native plants and animals, including many rare and protected species. Visitors can enjoy Scotland's regenerating Caledonian forest through exploration of ancient pinewood and unique juniper forest, discovery of centuries of Gaelic history, and connection with a landscape undergoing transformation through rewilding.

Opened in Spring 2023, the Dundreggan Rewilding Centre is a state-of-the-art venue nestled into a wild landscape brimming with natural and cultural heritage. It offers an immersive experience into the natural and cultural heritage of the Highlands, promoting a deeper understanding of rewilding through activities and engagement.

What is rewilding?

Rewilding is a process led by nature and facilitated by humans to create, protect and expand native habitats including a variety of woodlands, heathlands and peatlands – and it supports the animals that call those habitats home.

We believe rewilding is about working with nature not against it, following natural processes and seeing human activity as part of an intricate system in which everything is connected. The benefits of rewilding include natures recovery, climate change mitigation, and improved livelihoods and wellbeing.

Rewilding requires us to be bold in our approaches – we must all be driving towards leaving landscapes in better health than we inherited them so that we are all better able to face the challenges of the future.

At Dundreggan Rewilding Centre, we believe that the most effective teams thrive when they step away from their usual environment and immerse themselves in nature.



The Dundreggan Rewilding Centre offers a range of first-class facilities tailored to meet the needs of businesses seeking a unique and inspiring venue.

Meeting spaces

- An Taigh-ceilidh: A large presentation space accommodating up to 80 attendees, ideal for conferences, workshops, and exhibitions. This flexible area is equipped with a 98-inch smart screen, projector, audio system, and microphones, ensuring seamless presentations.
- Meeting Rooms A and B: These adaptable rooms can be used separately or combined, with capacities ranging from 15 to 30 adults. Each room features a 65-inch smart screen, flip chart, and complimentary high-speed Wi-Fi, making them perfect for breakout sessions or smaller meetings.
- Tipi: For a distinctive experience, the on-site tipi offers a unique space for up to 20 people, complete with seating and a fire bowl, fostering creativity and team bonding in a natural setting.

An Spiris: The centre provides comfortable lodging for up to 40 guests in 20 twin/double bedrooms, including four accessible rooms with wet rooms. The accommodation features boot rooms for drying outdoor gear and a spacious communal area with basic kitchen facilities, perfect for relaxation and informal gatherings after a day's activities.
